Dear Mr. Douglass:

On December 15, 2009, ISO-NE submitted revised tariff sheets to the ISO Tariff.<sup>1</sup> You state that the revisions are necessary to correct previous tariff revisions that were made before they became effective. You further state that some of the Tariff sheets being amended unintentionally included long-term firm transmission rights-related amendments that had been accepted but not yet become effective. The proposed revisions are accepted effective December 16, 2009 as requested.

Public notice of the filing was published in the Federal Register with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before January 5, 2010. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2009)).

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification or any rule, regulation or practice

affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against your company.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713 (2009).
