Dear Mr. Grabow:

On November 2, 2007, as amended on December 21, 2007, and January 22, 2008, United Illuminating Company (UI) filed revised tariff sheets amending Schedule 20A-UI, the formula rates for firm and non-firm point-to-point transmission service over UI's transfer capability on the Hydro-Quebec Interconnection. UI is proposing a modification to the denominator in the formula used to calculate the yearly demand charge, a modification to the calculation of daily firm and non-firm transmission service, and peak and off-peak pricing for daily and hourly non-firm transmission service (with all revenues credited to the firm service). Your proposed revisions are accepted for filing as designated<sup>1</sup> effective January 1, 2008, as requested.

The filing was noticed with comments due on or before January 31, 2008. No protests or adverse comments were filed.
