Dear Ms. Leitz:

On May 6, 2008, Northeast Utilities Service Company (NUSCO)¹ filed revised tariff sheets² to Schedule 21-NU to Section II of the ISO New England Inc. Open Access Transmission Tariff. NUSCO's proposed changes reflect corrections to inadvertent omissions of sub-accounts to FERC Accounts 456 and 561 made in a previous filing.³ The tariff sheets are accepted effective April 1, 2006, as requested.

Public notice of the filing was published in the Federal Register with comments, protests or interventions due on or before May 27, 2008. None were filed.
