What will I be required to report

- Directory #12, UFLS Program Requirements
 - To be sent out on July 15, 2010
 - ISO New England Market Participants (TO/DP/LSE/Load Aggregators) with UFLS obligations
 - Responses due August 30, 2010
 - Market Participants Automatic Underfrequency Load Shedding Capability data requested for **calendar year 2009**
- Directory #12, UFLS Implementation Plan Status
 - To be sent out on July 15, 2010
 - Responses due September 30, 2010
 - Status in implementing the new Directory #12 UFLS Program Requirements for conversions/modifications required at the end of Year One (1) – **June 26, 2010**

Compliance Assessment/Reporting

- Directory #12, UFLS Program Requirements
 - ISO New England, as the New England Balancing Authority, reports its compliance status to NPCC
 - ISO New England Compliance is dependent on the compliance of its UFLS obligated Market Participants
 - Non-compliance by a Market Participant may be referred to NPCC for enforcement action
- Directory #12, UFLS Implementation Plan Status
 - ISO New England, as the New England Balancing Authority, will compile the individual status reports and inform NPCC of the results
 - Market Participants not meeting the Implementation Plan milestones will be required to submit a mitigation plan to ISO-NE; mitigation plans will be referred to the Reliability Coordinating Committee of NPCC for consideration and further direction
